

Alternative Hours License Test Terms and Conditions

Applicant Requirements:

- Applicants under the age of 18 must hold a valid learner's permit for at least six months.
 - You should keep your driving record clean during this time. A suspension will invalidate the permit and the six months will start to run anew when the suspension is lifted.
- Complete a driver's education program and receive a certificate.
 - The RMV issues the certificate once all of the requirements of driver's education have been fulfilled and the certificate fee has been paid.
- Complete 40 hours of supervised driving.
 - A parent or guardian will be required to sign the license test application verifying the completion of these driving hours.
- Applicants over the age of 18 only need a valid learner's permit to sign up for a road test.
- Applicants under the age of 18 must have completed a driver's education course and have their certificate issued before enrolling for a license test.

Additional Details:

- Applicants must not have any other license test scheduled with the RMV if they are requesting an alternate hours test. Any other scheduled exam will prevent Chelmsford Auto School from scheduling a test. If you are not a student of Chelmsford Auto School you MUST call our office before signing up so that we can register you as our student in the RMV database. Failure to do so will prevent you from taking a license test at our location.
- Chelmsford Auto School submits a list of students to the RMV on the Monday two weeks prior to the tentative Saturday exam date requesting an examiner to give license tests on that day. Once this list has been submitted we are unable to reschedule or cancel the request. There is a possibility that the RMV may reschedule or cancel all road tests.
 - If the tests have been <u>rescheduled</u> by the RMV then the new date may be any day between the next day (Sunday) and the following Friday. Applicants are expected to show up for the rescheduled exam date or risk paying the RMV exam fee.

• In the event of the RMV <u>cancelling</u> the road tests, Chelmsford Auto School will contact every applicant on the list and ask if he/she would like to go on the next available Saturday test date at our office.

Alternative Hours License Test Fees:

- Chelmsford Auto School:
 - \$20 non-refundable deposit at the time of sign-up.
 - \$100 cash only due on the day of the test.
- RMV:
 - \$50 fee for an applicant's 5-year license.
 - \$35 for a license test.
